A simple checklist for after the day

IN THE FIRST FEW DAYS

- ✓ Take a moment to pause and take it all in
 - ✓ Ensure your marriage has been registered (this is completed by your celebrant)
 - ✓ Apply for your official marriage certificate (if not already arranged)
 - ✓ Rest and recover after the day
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IN THE FIRST FEW WEEKS

- ✓ Send thank you messages or cards
 - ✓ Connect with your photographer to receive your images
 - ✓ Finalise any outstanding supplier items (albums, videos, etc.)
 - ✓ Return any hired items
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IF YOU ARE CHANGING YOUR NAME

- ✓ Decide what name feels right for you
 - ✓ Obtain your official marriage certificate
 - ✓ Update your driver's licence
 - ✓ Update your bank accounts and financial details
 - ✓ Work through other organisations (ATO, Medicare, employer, etc.)
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PRACTICAL LIFE UPDATES

- ✓ Update your address (if required)
- ✓ Review your will
- ✓ Update emergency contacts and next of kin details
- ✓ Review insurance and superannuation beneficiaries

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A FINAL NOTE

There is no rush with any of this.

Some things can be done straight away.

Others can wait.

The most important part has already happened.

Everything else will fall into place in time.
