START HERE

Share the moment

 - How you want it to feel

LAYING THE FOUNDATIONS

Set a realistic budget

Know your limits early. It makes every decision easier.

Get organised your way

Simple systems work best.

Create a mood board

Not for perfection. Just alignment.

Start looking at venues

Your venue shapes everything.

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BUILDING YOUR TEAM

Lock in key suppliers early

- Celebrant
- Photographer
- Videographer

The right people matter more than trends.

Choose your support people

Your wedding party should feel like support, not obligation.

Take inspiration, not pressure

You don't need to decide everything now.

12–6 MONTHS OUT

Start outfit planning

Book entertainment

Plan food and drink

Send save-the-dates if needed

6–2 MONTHS OUT

Refine your style and details

Organise your guest list

Order your stationery

Start thinking about your ceremony

- Readings
- Vows

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- Structure

FINAL MONTH

Create a simple timeline

Confirm suppliers

Final fittings and seating plan

Give small roles to trusted people

THE FINAL WEEK

Slow down.

You've done the work.

Spend time with your people.

Prepare what you need and let go of the rest.

THE DAY BEFORE

Rest.

Take it in.

This moment won't come again.

AFTER THE WEDDING

Enjoy being married.

Say thank you.

Take your time returning to normal life.

A FINAL NOTE

There is a lot of noise in the wedding industry.

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A lot of “you should do this.”

A lot of timelines, trends, and expectations.

But at the centre of it all is something simple:

Two people choosing each other.

If you hold onto that, everything else becomes easier.
